This letter addresses the 2011 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Program and an update on the Cherry Hills North Metropolitan District (CHNMD) Storm Sewer Investigation.

2011 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Program:

Attached is the copy of the 2011 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Program report. The memorandum dated September 28, 2011 contained within the report summarizes the findings of this year's video and jet cleaning programs performed by Dale's Environmental Service (DES).

The recommendations from this year's program identifies the following:

- 1. Jet clean an additional 319 feet of pipe with moderate to severe debris in the lines.
- 2. Root removal in 1,082 feet of pipe due to moderate to severe roots
- 3. Install Cured-in-Place pipe in one (1) reach of 278 feet due to moderate cracks.

The opinion of probable costs associated with this work is included in the memorandum.

Due to concerns of sewage backup and sanitary sewer overflows, the additional jet cleaning and root removal has been scheduled with DES and should be completed within the next few weeks. Since a couple of these reaches are in easements along the east side of the District's boundaries this work needs to be performed before the weather changes. These runs are identified on a map of the CHNMD facilities under the *Unscheduled Maintenance* tab of the report.

The one (1) run recommended for Cured-In-Place pipe due to moderate cracks is suggested to be postponed until a later date and will be placed with the three (3) remaining runs that were not performed with the 2010 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Program. A map of the locations of these four (4) runs are included on a map of the CHNMD facilities under the *Capital Improvement* tab.

These four (4) runs will be closely monitored under next year's video & jet cleaning program to better budget and evaluate when this work will be required. In keeping with the "Sinking Fund Analysis" project and the projected scheduling of replacement facilities over time, we would anticipate this work would be performed in 2013. This also provides a reasonable accumulation of pipe footage to receive an economy of scale with a longer project size. The only unknown is whether some change in condition or a repair will need immediate attention during the video & jet cleaning performed with the 2012 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Program.

An addition to this year's report is a map referred to as "Historical Capital Improvements". This map identifies by color and date the two (2) completed Cured-In-Place Programs with the specific location of the Capital Improvement Projects that were conducted in 2007 and 2010. We hope this provides the Board the visual perspective of the remaining infrastructure to be replaced over time. This map is included under the *Capital Improvement* tab.

The Video Tape and Photo tab includes DES's logs and photos of this year's video programs in addition to our review comments. The Scheduled Maintenance tab includes the database and update for this year's program. This information is developed and maintained for comparative analysis from the CHNMD sanitary sewer investigation historical data from year to year.

CHNMD Storm Sewer Investigation:

The other task that we have been investigating for the Board is the existing storm sewer system within the boundaries of the CHNMD subdivision. We have previously emailed copies of the easements, correspondence and drawings that were obtained from the City of Cherry Hills Village. We have added these facilities to the District's key maps. A copy of the map is attached in order that the Board can gain an understanding of the extent of the existing system.

Unfortunately none of the information retrieved for the City of Cherry Hills Village included size or type of pipe material associated with the storm sewer system.

Since it appears that CHNMD has assumed some ownership and maintenance responsibility of these facilities; we would recommend that DES jet clean and/or TV this system to review the condition of these facilities.

Even though we have discussed this issue with DES, they will need a sense of size and the length of pipe involved to provide a cost estimate for TV & jet cleaning. We will prepare a footage takeoff from the CHNMD plat and estimate pipe sizes from the exposed street inlets when DES is onsite to complete this year's jet cleaning & root sawing.

The Division has reviewed the ballot question for Cherry Hills North Metropolitan District's (the "District") May 4, 2014 election. We have reviewed ballot issue 5A and have determined the language is sufficient to remove the District from the statutory property tax revenue limitation of C.R.S. 29-1-301, et seq (the "5.5%" limit). Therefore, the Division rescinds the above-referenced ORDER to Reduce Property Tax Revenue.

The District has now been removed from the Division's property tax revenue limit calculation program and the Division will no longer calculate a property tax revenue limit for the District. Please notify the Division of any future property tax ballot issues that affect this taxing jurisdiction's operating mill levy. Please understand our determination that the language of the ballot question has removed the District from the 5.5% limitation <u>does not deem the language to be above legal challenge</u>.
