CHERRY HILLS NORTH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT

2020 BUDGET MESSAGE

The 2020 budget of Cherry Hills North Metropolitan District is prepared using the accrual basis of accounting. The principle services offered by Cherry Hills North Metropolitan District include providing wastewater service to the property owners within the District and to maintain the neighborhood signs.

The budgeted revenues for 2020 total \$119,289. Approximately 96% of the revenues are received from taxpayers in the form of property and ownership taxes. In May 2014, District held an election to increase the mill levy by 4 mills to 8.281 mills to allow the District to fully fund operations from operating revenues. The remaining revenue is from investment income generated from money market funds.

The total budgeted expenditures for 2020 total \$199,504. Approximately 39% of the total expenditures are allocated to maintenance and repair of the wastewater system; 43% of the total expenditures are allocated to a wastewater line replacement reserve; 5% of the total budged expenditures are allocated to lighting, maintenance and repair of the neighborhood signs; 13% of the budgeted expenditures are allocated to administrative expenses including insurance expense, professional fees, dues and county fees.

The District wastewater is treated by Metro Wastewater Reclamation District. The wastewater flows to Metro Wastewater via an outfall line that is owned by Hillcrest Water and Sanitation District and connected to a total of five districts. The five districts entered into the second amended and restated intergovernmental agreement effective January 1, 2011. This agreement allows Hillcrest Water & Sanitation District to perform maintenance and improvements to the line and establishes a cost sharing agreement of the maintenance/improvement costs and treatment fees between the five districts based upon the number of single family equivalent sewer taps within each district. Hillcrest Water & Sanitation District bills each district for the pro-rata maintenance costs and treatment fees. Cherry Hills North Metro District is responsible for 19.5% of the costs. The Metro Wastewater treatment fees and Outfall Line maintenance costs total \$60,776 in the 2020 budget; this is 90% of the maintenance and repair costs for Cherry Hills North Metro District.

RESOLUTION TO SET MILL LEVIES

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2019 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE CHERRY HILLS NORTH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, ARAPAHOE COUNTY, COLORADO FOR THE 2020 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Cherry Hills North Metropolitan District has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on November 7, 2019;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$107,169;

WHEREAS, the 2019 net valuation for assessment for the Cherry Hills North Metropolitan District as certified by the Arapahoe County Assessor is \$12,941,509;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Cherry Hills North Metropolitan District, Arapahoe County, Colorado:

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Cherry Hills North Metropolitan District during the 2020 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 8.281 mills for General Operating Expenses upon each dollar of the net valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2019.

<u>Section 2.</u> That Darcy Beard, Budget Officer is hereby authorized and direct to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Arapahoe County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Cherry Hills North Metropolitan District as hereinabove determined and set, with said certification to be filed with said County Commissioners on or before December 15, 2019.

RESOLUTION

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Cherry Hills North Metropolitan District that:

- 1. The District shall hold an election on May 5, 2020. Such election shall be conducted as an independent mail ballot election, pursuant to C.R.S. § 1-13.5-1101, et seq.
- 2. Darcy Beard shall be the Designated Election Official on behalf of the District and is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with any action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the election on May 5, 2020.
- 3. If the only matter before the electors is the election of Directors of the District and if, at the close of business on March 3, 2020, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at the election, including candidates timely filed affidavits of intent no later than Monday, March 2, 2020, the Designated Election Official shall cancel the election and declare the candidates elected. Notice of such cancellation shall be published and posted in accordance with applicable law.
- 4. If any part of provision of this Resolution is adjudged to be unenforceable or invalid, such judgement shall not affect, impair or invalidated the remaining provisions of this Resolution, it being the Board's intention that the various provisions hereof are severable.
- 5. The provisions of this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
